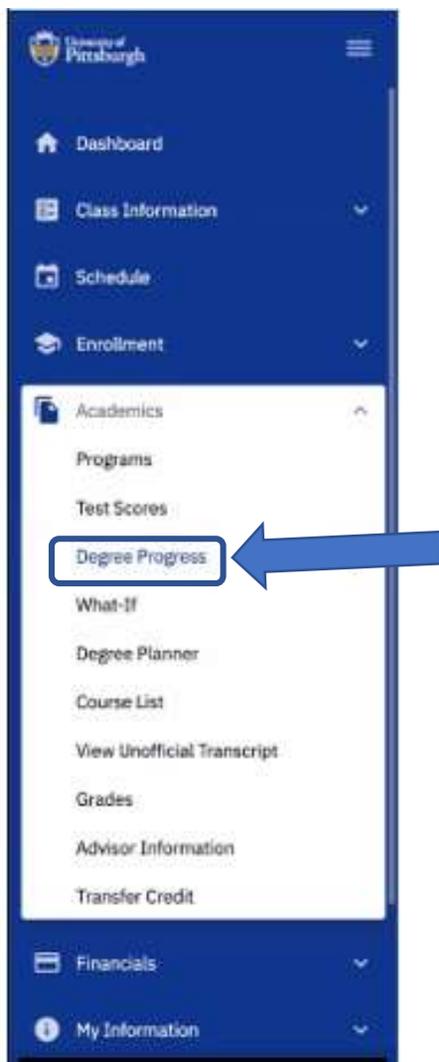
1. Access PeopleSoft/HighPoint CX through **my.pitt.edu**.
