

HOW TO ADD COURSES TO YOUR SHOPPING CART

Enrolling in Courses through PeopleSoft (Student Information System)

Step 1: Log in to <https://my.pitt.edu> using your Pitt username and password.

Step 2: Search for Student Center.

Step 3: In the upper left-hand corner, click on **Main Menu**, then **Self-Service**, and then **Student Center**.

Step 4: From your **Student Center**, click on **Enroll** along the left-hand side. This will take you to your enrollment shopping cart.

Class Notes	<p>This course addresses critical issues in the history of painting, sculpture, photography, and architecture from the mid-19th century to the late 20th century. The first weeks will be devoted to discussion of the history and cultural practices of artistic Modernism with special attention to the work of the Impressionists, the Surrealists, and the Abstract Expressionists among others. The second part of the course will explore the significance of feminist and multicultural challenges to the Modernist tradition and the role of those challenges in the profound redefinition of Western culture unfolding in our society today. Enrollment in a recitation section is required of all students. Recitations will provide an opportunity for more in-depth consideration of issues raised in lecture.</p>

Description	
<p>The course will present a chronological survey of Western European, Russian, and American art from the mid-nineteenth century to the present (impressionism to post-modernism). In addition to charting the dramatic stylistic and conceptual changes in art during this time period, the course will consider the historical circumstances which caused a disintegration in accepted notions of what constituted a significant work of art.</p>
