The Latin minor introduces students to the Latin language, enabling students to develop a competence in reading the language through textbook drills and stories that illustrate the Roman way of life. The minor polishes this introductory knowledge through close readings of selected prose and verse texts.

Required courses for the Latin minor

The Latin minor requires at least 15 credits of Latin courses for completion. Students may complete the minor by taking courses at the beginning, intermediate, and advanced levels.

Checklist for the Latin minor

Beginning and Intermediate courses; all of the following courses are required

- LATIN 0101 Beginning Latin 1
- LATIN 0102 Beginning Latin 2
- LATIN 0210 Intermediate Latin: Prose
- LATIN 0220 Intermediate Latin: Poetry

Advanced course; choose one of the following courses

- GREEK 1400 Greek Reading, Epic
- GREEK 1402 Greek Reading, Drama
